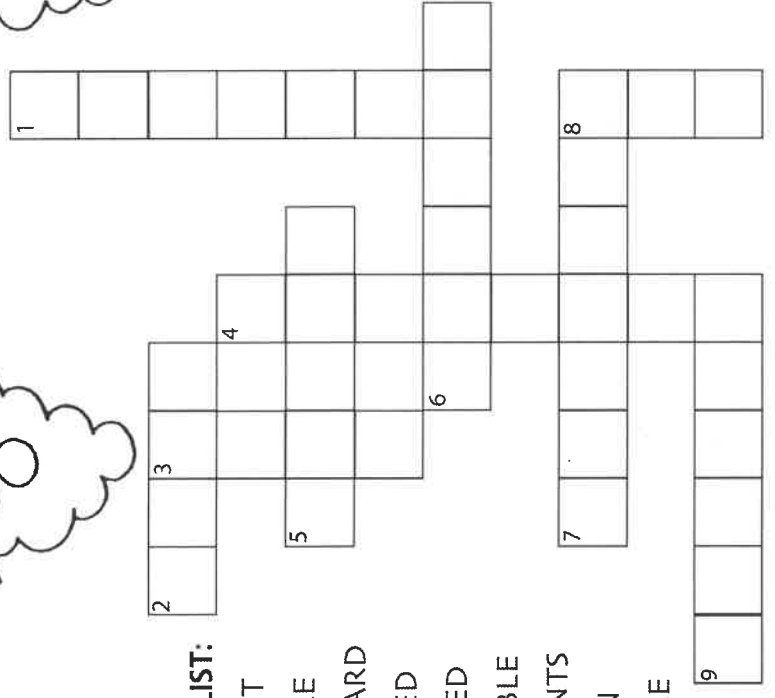
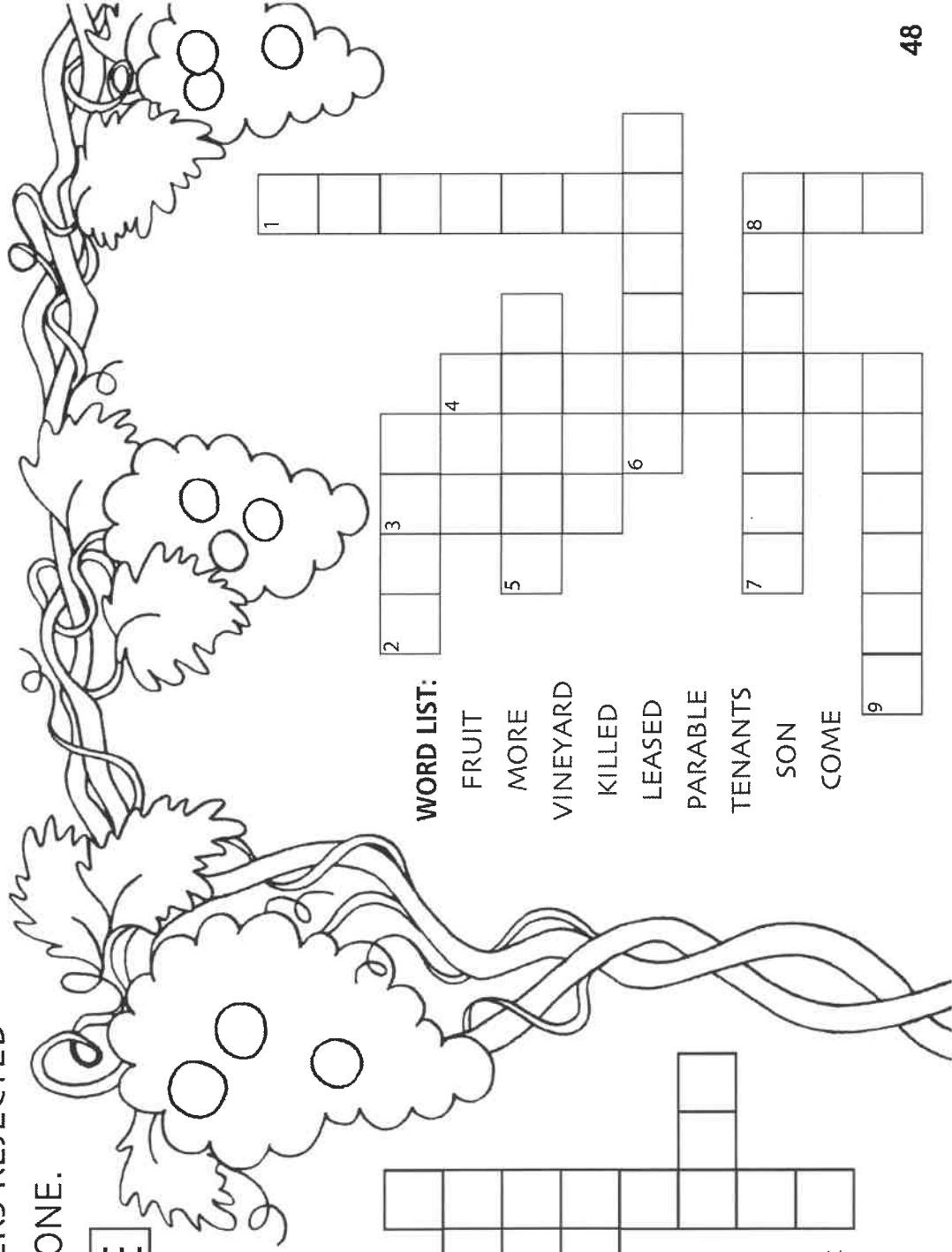


Rejected means "didn't want."
