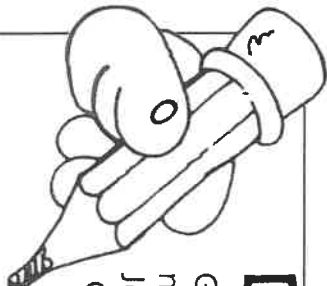


# DOT to DOT

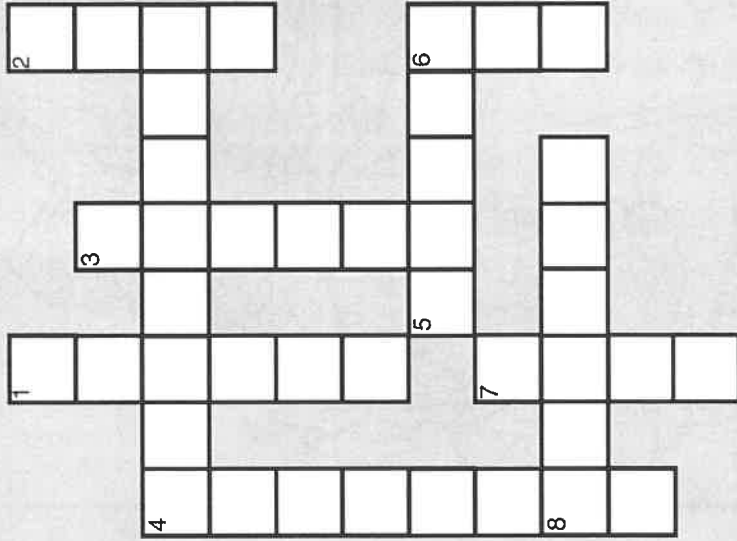
# Crossword Puzzle

John 18:1-19:42

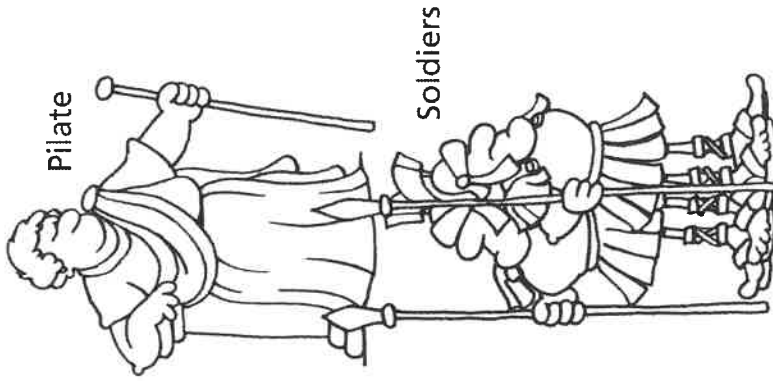
See if you can put words from today's Gospel into the crossword puzzle. (If you need help, use the word list.)

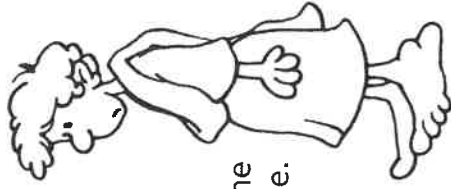

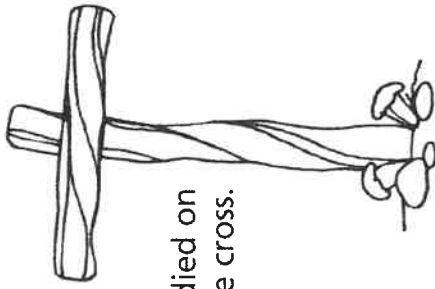
