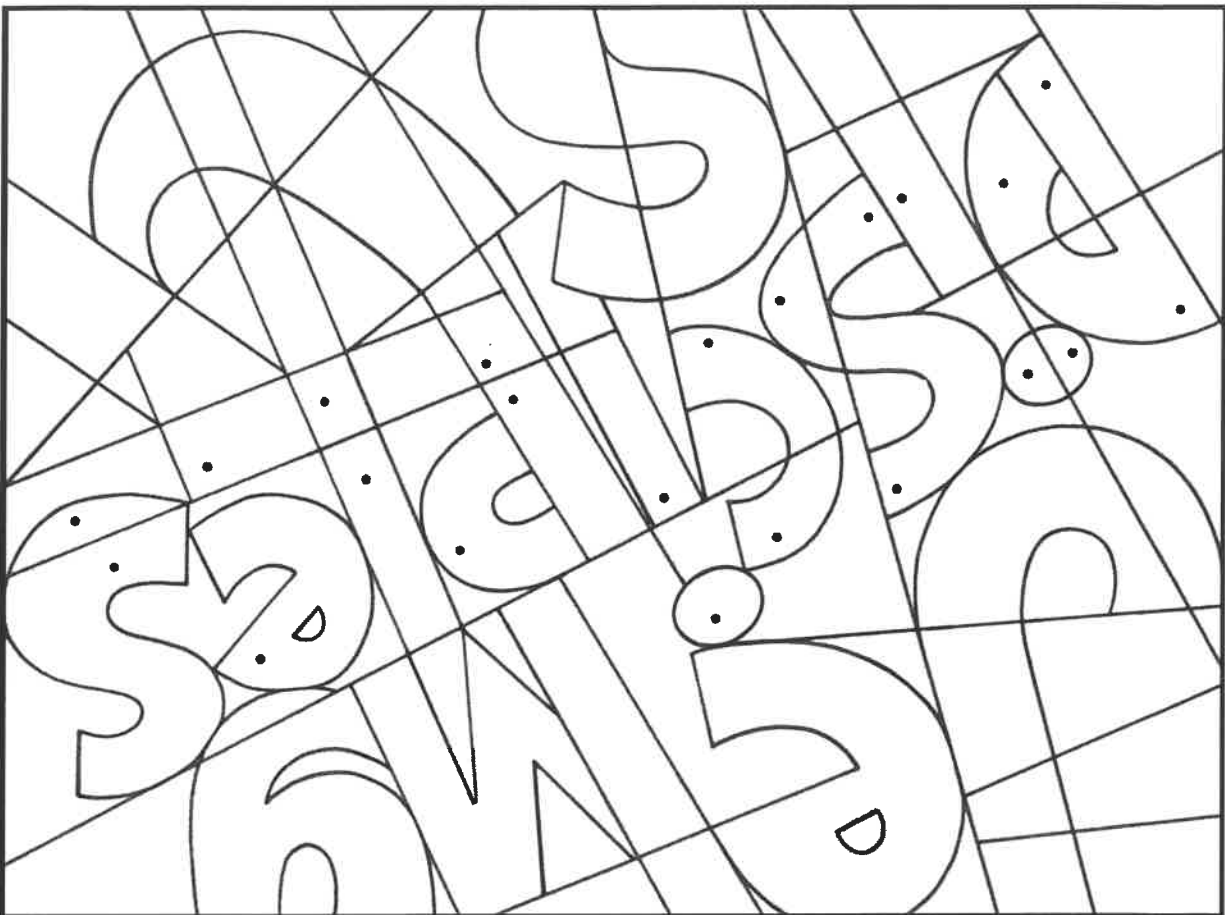


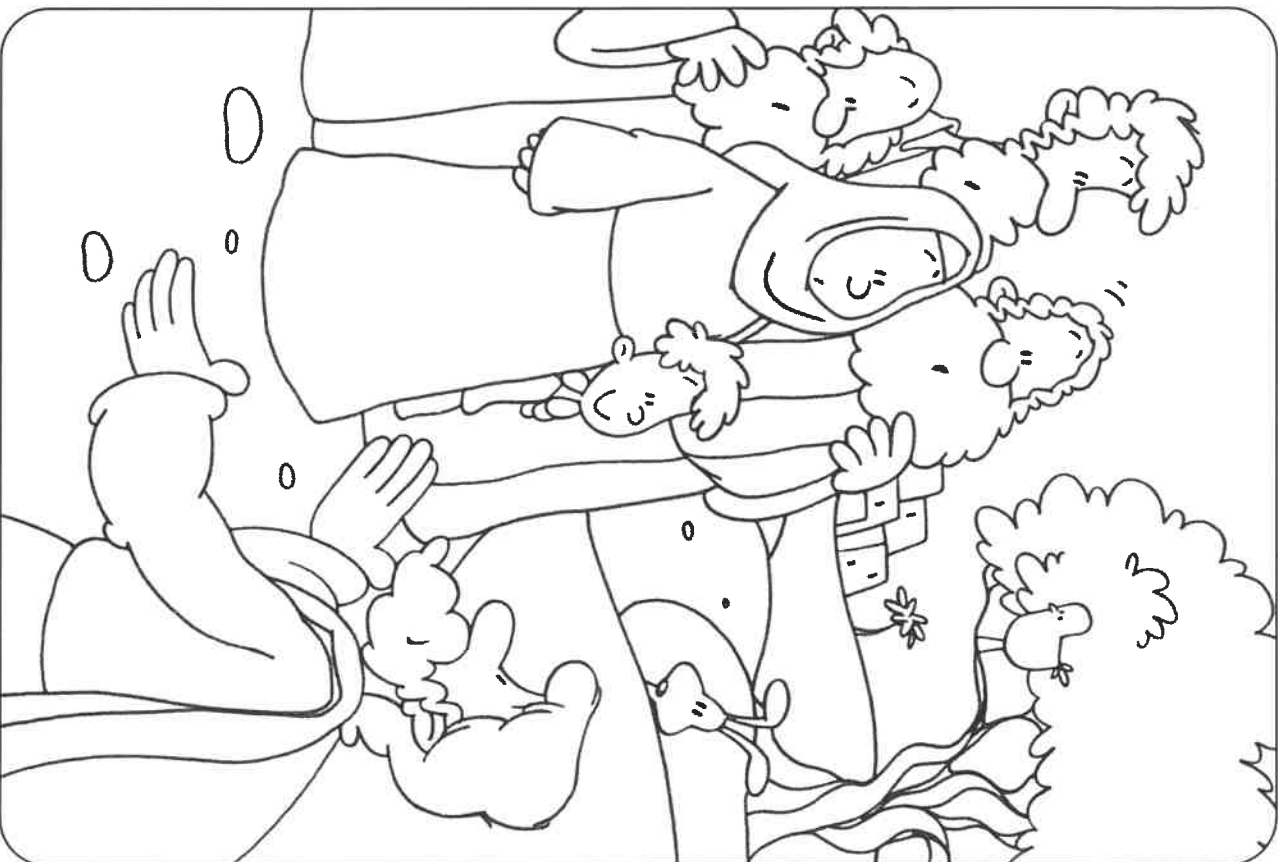
HIDDEN WORD

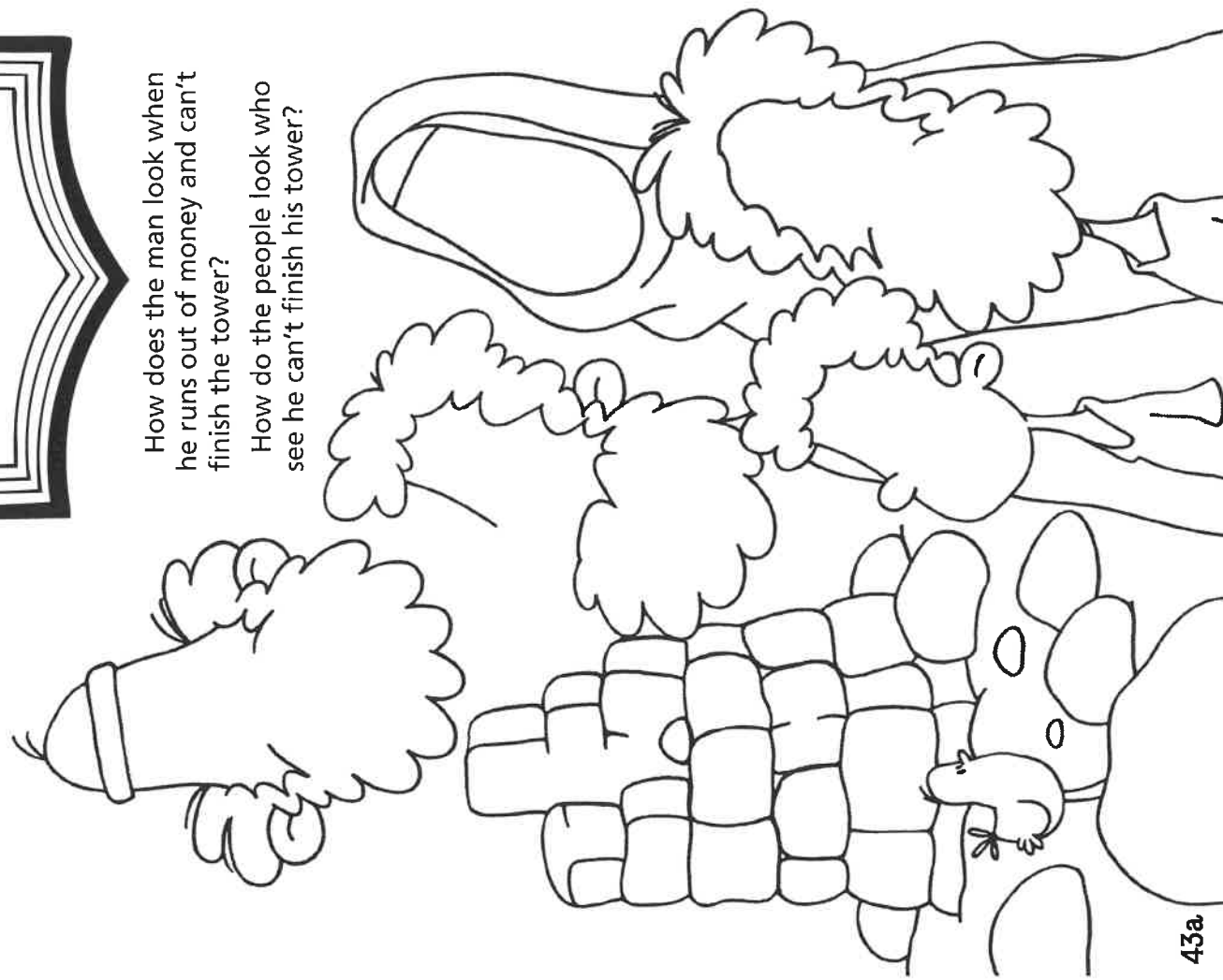


Whoever does not bear his own cross and come after Me cannot be My disciple.

In today's Gospel, Jesus tells a story about a man who decides to build a tower.

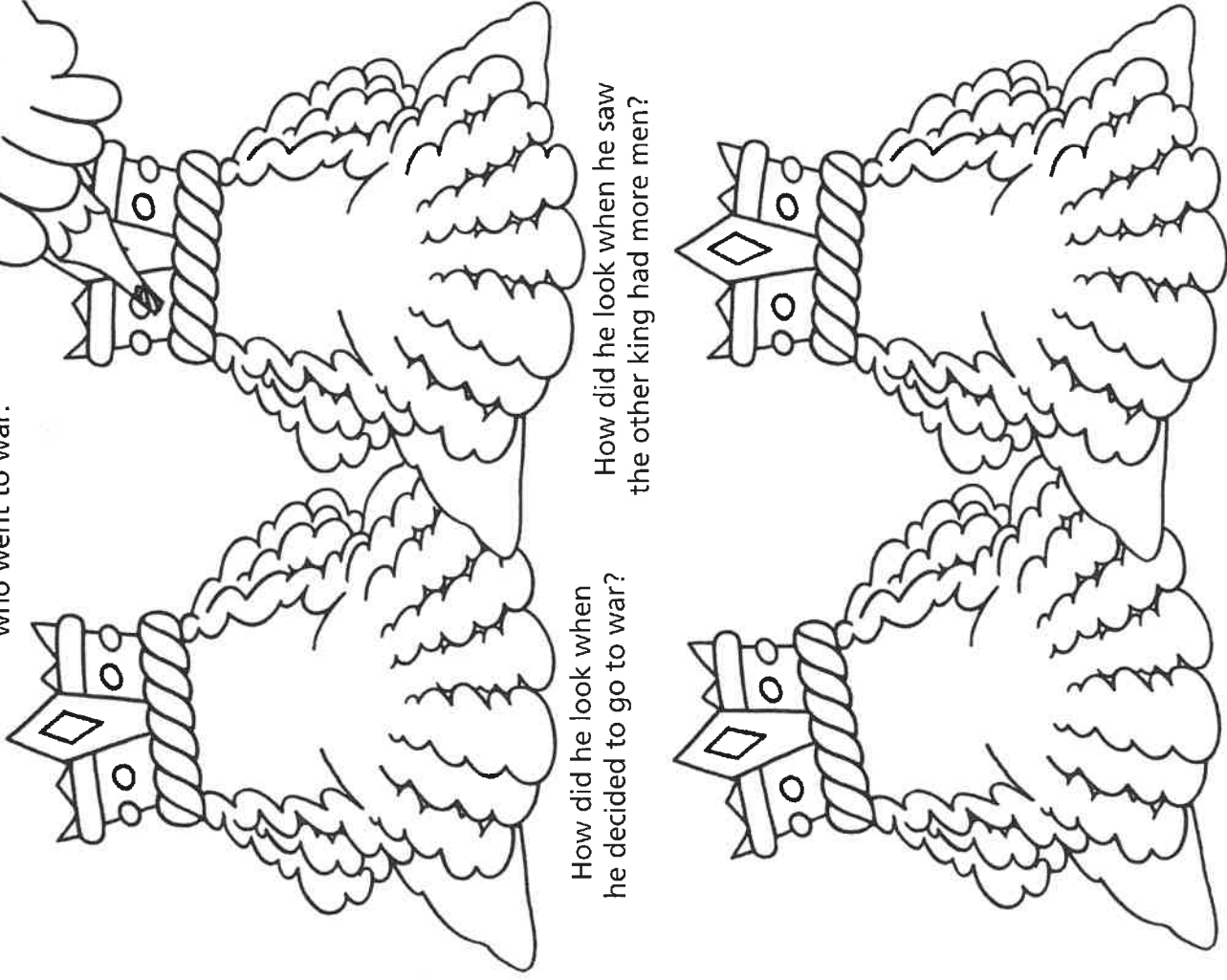


How does the man look when he runs out of money and can't finish the tower?

Jesus told another story about a king who went to war.

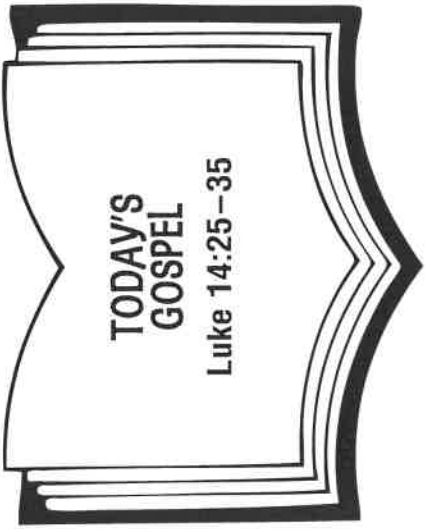


How did he look when he decided to go to war?
