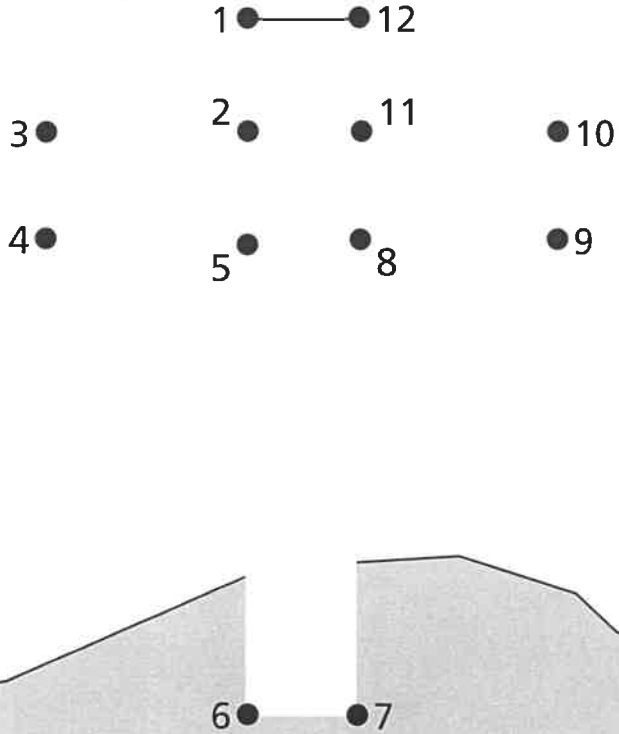


# DOT to DOT

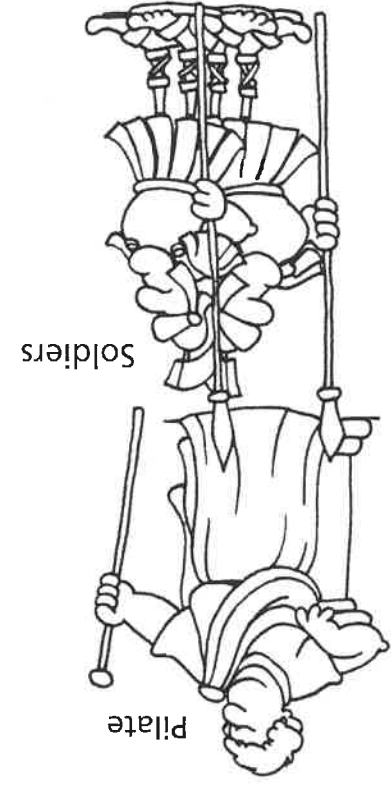

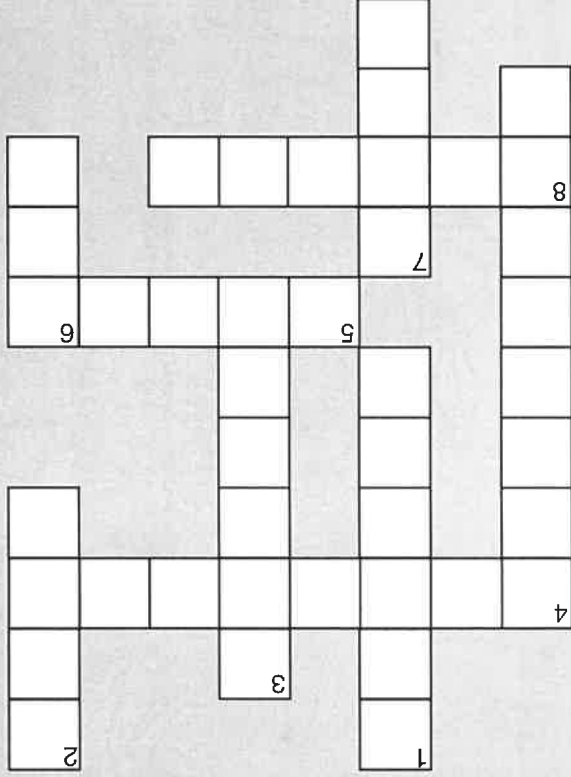

# CROSSWORD PUZZLE

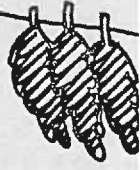
See if you can put words from today's Gospel into the crossword puzzle. (If you need help, use the word list.)
