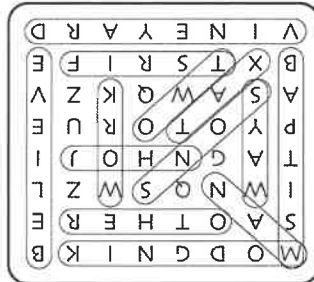

Draw a picture of you doing something for your parents.

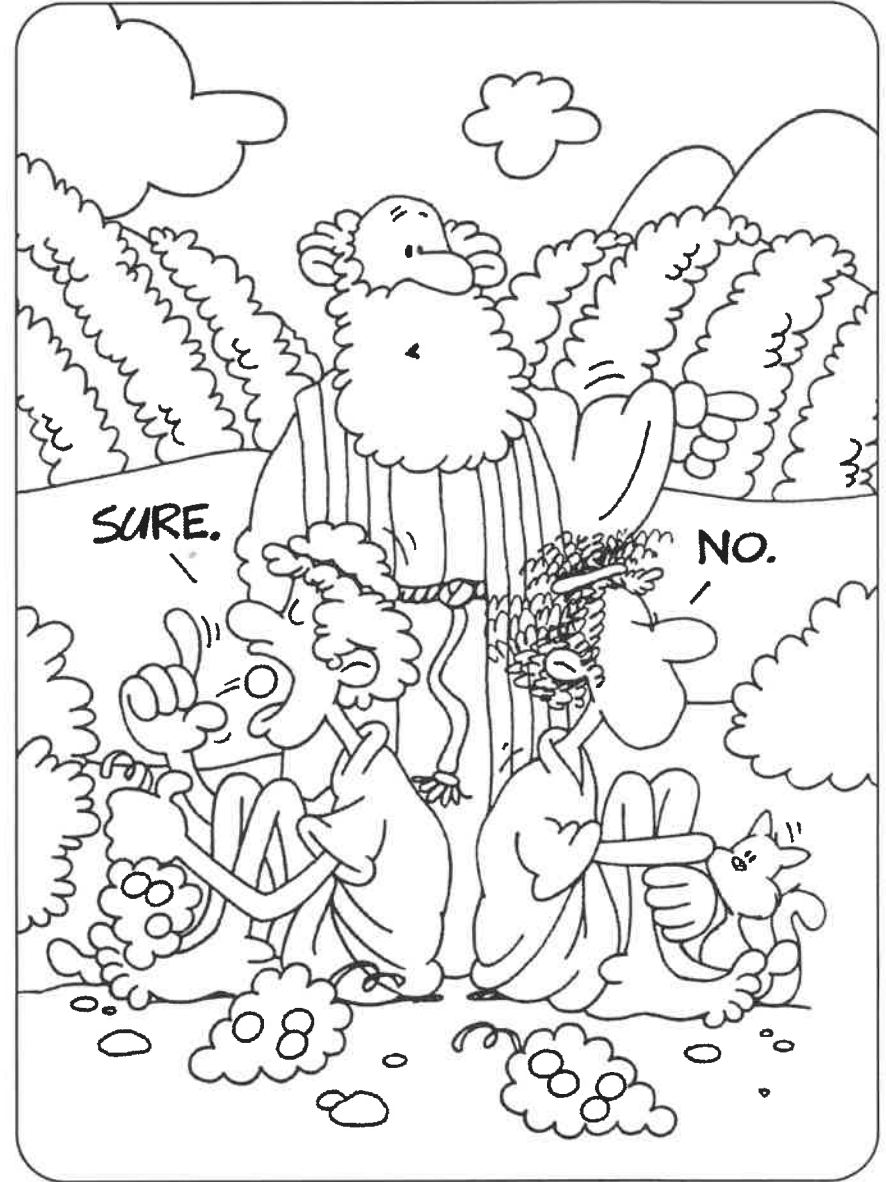


### ANSWERS WORD SEARCH

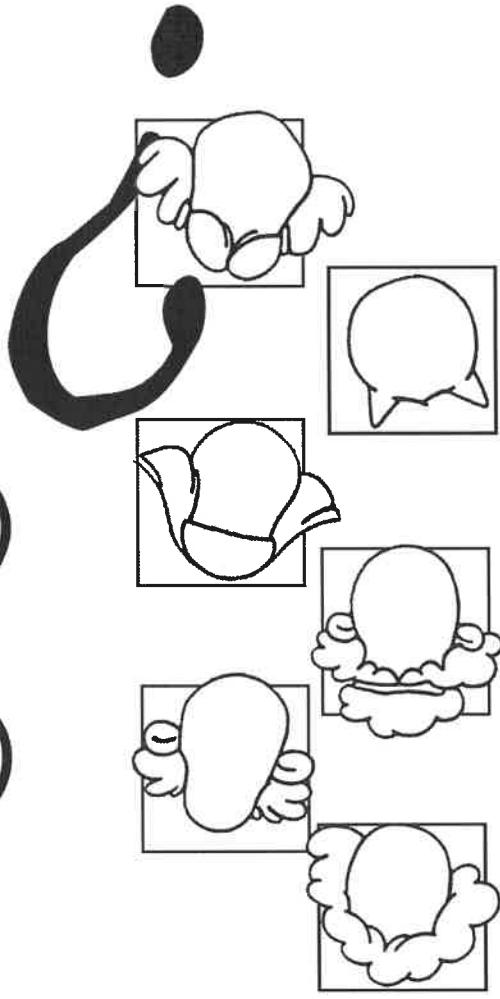
# WORD SEARCH
