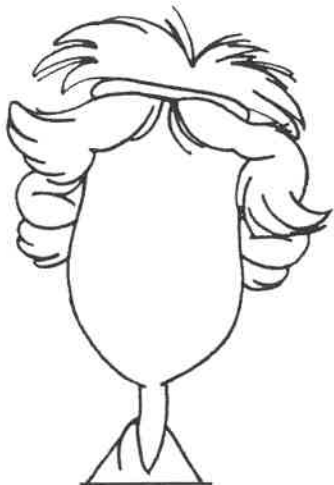

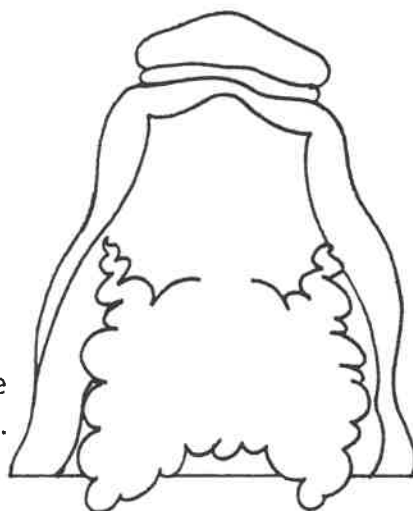
Draw faces on these people from today's Gospel.



This worker started last and got full pay.



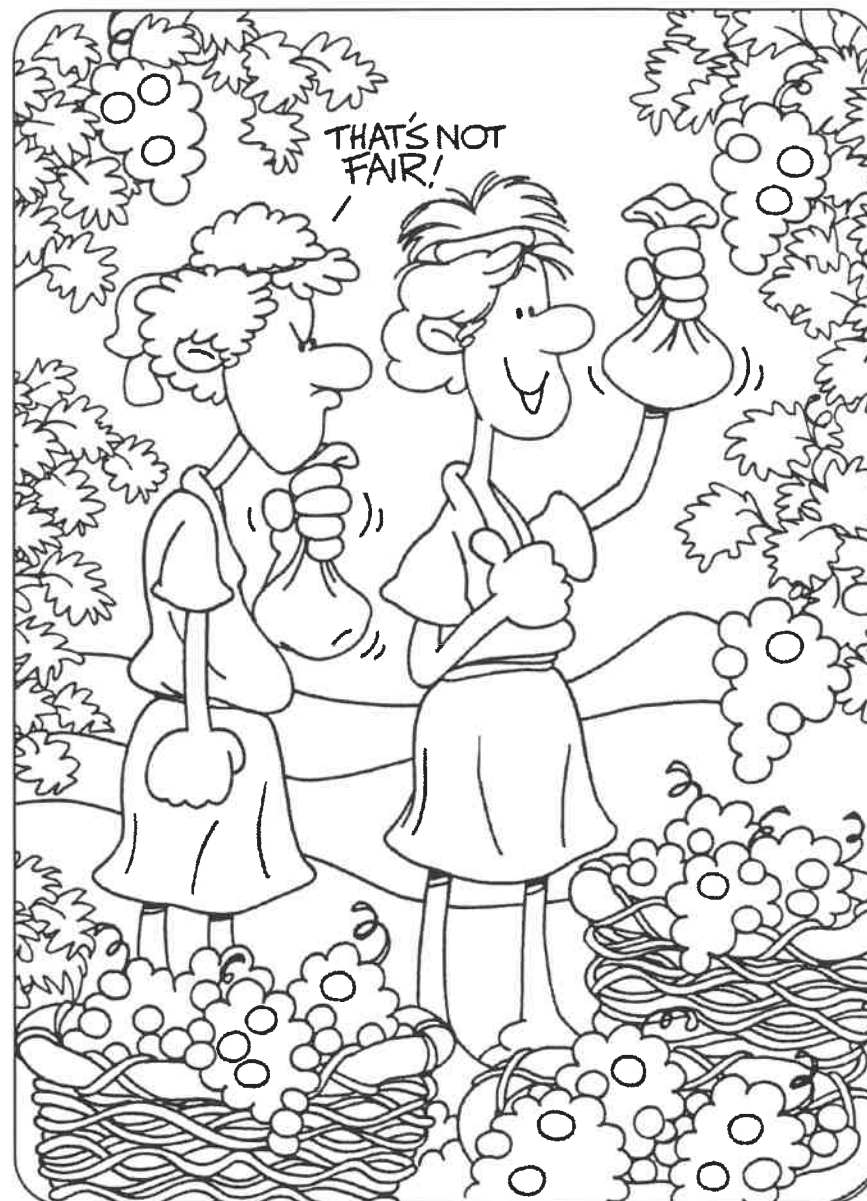
This worker started first and got full pay.

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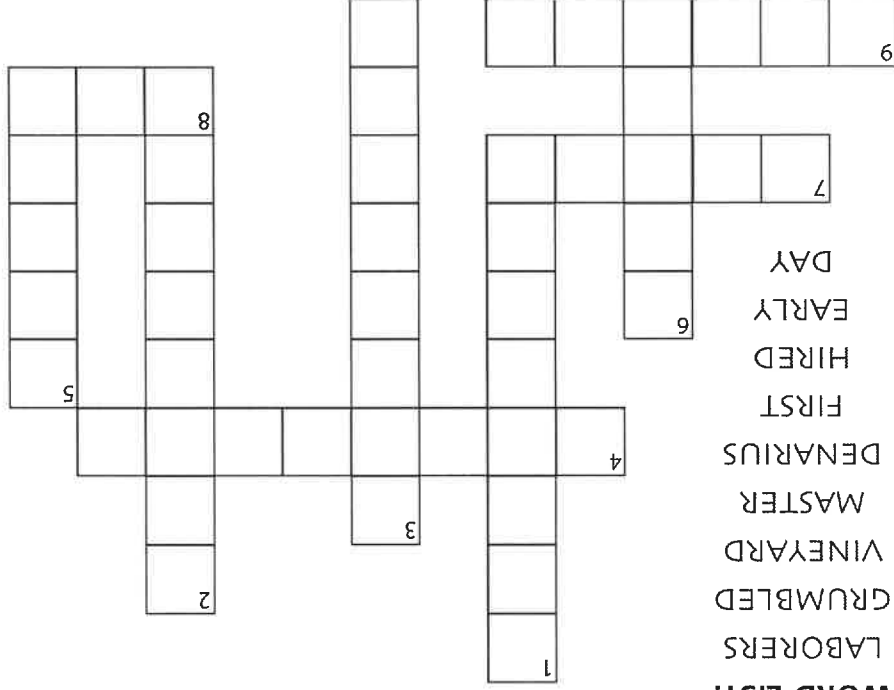
